METHODS OF ENHANCEMENT OF EFFECTIVENESS OF A TEACHER:

- 1 .Seize the moment
- 2. Involve the student in playing 'begin with from what the student knows
- 3. Move from Simple To Complex
- 4. Students Preferred Learning Style
- 5. Set goals by learning domain
- 6. Plan for periodic tests
- 7. Reward the students

Different ways of teaching: To develop skill, teacher needs patience, hard work and command over the subject:

Method, Approach and Technique are also important

Types of teaching:

Active, passive, learner oriented and teacher oriented

Lecture, project, laboratory, dogmatic and heuristic.

Teaching method vs teaching strategy

Teaching method involves only presentation and control over the students, whereas strategy involves presentation, attitude of the student abilities and task analysis

Development of teaching methods: Micro and Macro methods involve skill time and presentation .14 skills were identified in teaching by Ryan and Allen

Individual skills of teaching: Herbartian Approach
